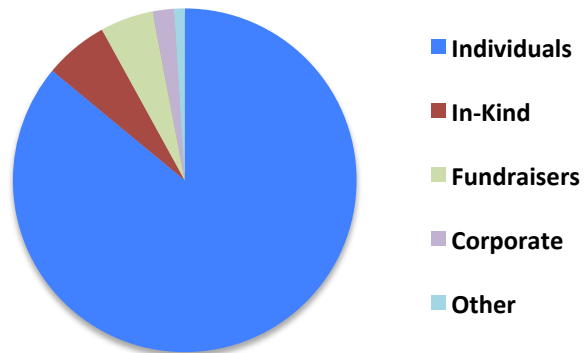

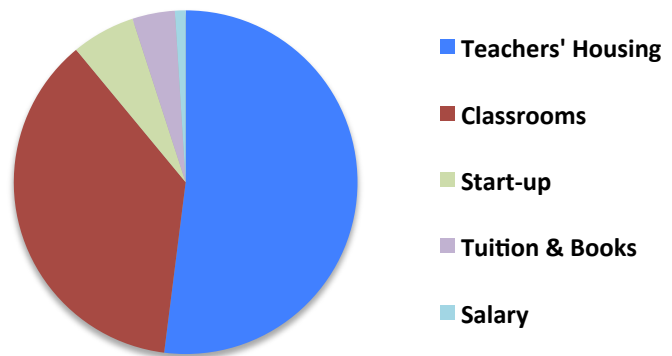

New Classrooms

Three new classrooms and an office for teachers were built this year to include solar electricity and ceiling fans for the first time in the region. This will relieve severe overcrowding.

Housing for Teachers

Four new houses were built and three existing houses were renovated to replace the single, dilapidated house that was being used. Solar electricity was installed in all houses.

Books for Students

Textbooks were purchased so each child would have books for every subject instead of a single book being shared among several children.

KAFO's partnership with the Mami Siara Na Association of Konkourona, a group of more than 400 villagers working together to support their own development, is critical.
